

Installation





700 Wunschbohnen

2022

700 pole bean seeds, table, chair, envelopes, pencils, shredder.

The installation 700 Wunschbohnen is a participatory installation: visitors are invited to choose a bean and put it in the envelope. The seating area is used to think of a wish, write it on the paper and finally shred the paper. Visitors can take the envelope with the bean home and sow the bean next year - the wish will thank them. In spring, Piero Good will compost the shredded wishlists to turn them into fertile soil.

The two bean varieties *Von Ennetbürgen* and *Blauhilde* are both ProSpecieRara pole beans.

Wasteland Plant Magnificent 2022

Sculpture

The place where the exhibition took place is the remains of an abandoned cement factory in Brunnen SZ. Between the empty buildings there is a huge wasteland. Where there was once no plant life, there are now shrubs, trees, herbs and flowers: the basis for a new ecosystem.

In the fall, we collected seeds of the plants on the wasteland - they are seeds of wild cardoon, water astragal, wild carrot and many more.

In spring I sowed the seeds to grow seedlings. This took place at a sculpture built especially for this purpose, where each little plant has its place. It serves as a reverence to the wild plants of Nova Brunnen.

During the exhibition, visitors are invited to walk around the sculpture and choose a seedling, take it home and give it a new place to live.

Plant Breeding Club

2021/2023

Dry runner bean plants, ropes, stone, table, envelopes Installation


I received seeds of local runner beans "Von Ennetbürgen" (2021) and "Forelle aus Thusis" (2023). In May I distributed the seeds to different gardeners in the city. They grew the plants for me over the summer without harvesting a bean. In the fall, when the plants and their pods had dried, we dug them up together with the roots.

In the exhibition spaces they float in space. Visitors are invited to cut off some pods and take them home in the envelope provided. The beans in the pods are the seeds for the next generation of "Von Ennerbürgen" and "Forelle aus Thusis". The envelope contains tips on growing and propagating the runner beans aswell as information on seed policy, and a request to document your own cultivation of the plant.

Using a hollow bamboo stick as an amplifier one can hear a beautiful melody created by dripping water drops.








During three hours 13 coloured dots descended from the surrounding mountains approaching slowly the village square of Unterwasser where the Vernissge took place.

The hilly and mountainous Calanques in Marseille with it's typical circumstances - the sun and the wind - offered a perfect venue to go up to the summits and reflect the sun rays with a mirror using morse language and raise a flag.

It Stands Still and I Move

I stepped out of Kulturfolger and saw the tower on the summit of Uetliberg, blinking for someones attention. From this moment on, I'm seeing the tower constantly, and from everywhere - blinking or not. I realise that I circle around it. I realise that I move and it stands still. I realise that I'm situated in a certain environment. I experience this very moment consciously by paying attention to the environment and by positioning myself in it: I am part of it.


